GRELEN  TRAILS

THE GRELEN TRAILS WERE FOUNDED IN 2015 TO CELEBRATE AND PRESERVE OUR BEAUTIFUL 1,000 ACRES IN THE VIRGINIA FOOTHILLS. GRELEN & JAMES MADISON'S MONTEPIELIER COLLABORATED WITH PIEDMONT ENVIRONMENTAL COUNCIL (PEC) TO CREATE A CONNECTOR TRAIL (NOW DESIGNATED A VIRGINIA TREASURE) TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO BOTH PROPERTIES. THERE ARE OPTIONS FOR ALL AGES AND SKILLS ... TAKE A WALK UP TO A GORGEOUS VISTA OVERLOOKING GRELEN NURSERY OR GO FOR A LONG RUN/HIKE THROUGH THE NURSERY, MEADOWS, AND OLD-GROWTH FOREST. INCLUDING MONTEPIELIER'S SYSTEM, THERE ARE OVER 15 MILES OF HIKING TRAILS TO EXPLORE. BOTH TRAIL SYSTEMS ARE FREE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

TRAIL RULES



BLOOMFIELD LOOP

Entering behind the pole barn and through the gate, The Bloomfield loop takes you through Grelen's old-growth forest and meadows. This is also where you'll find the connector trail to Montpelier's Visitor Center.

DUNCAN TRAIL

The Duncan Trail is Grelen's newest trail system, offering breathtaking views through the valley and from the highest point of The Grelen Trails, The Grelen Overlook.

NURSERY TRAIL

The Nursery Trail connects the Yager Loop and Bloomfield loop. Enjoy a stroll through Grelen's tree rows, with a scenic stop at the Bloomfield Pole Barn.

YAGER LOOP

The Yager loop is part of Grelen's original trail system. The pond and Orchard Overlook are popular spots to enjoy a picnic lunch from The Market at Grelen's Casual Cafe.
